

Washington EMC rate schedules

Effective June 1, 2010

Residential Service Rate 01

Summer (May through September)

Base Charge \$19.50

First 800 kwh @ 9.70¢ per kwh
Over 800 kwh @ 11.60¢ per kwh

Winter (October through April)

Base Charge \$19.50

First 800 kwh @ 9.70¢ per kwh
Over 800 kwh @ 8.50¢ per kwh

[Plus any power cost adjustment and applicable tax.]
